

Compliance with HB 3693

All Cities will comply with the requirements of House Bill 3693 (Government Code § 2265.001(b)) by compiling and posting the following information as soon as practicable after January 1, 2011:

- 1) The total metered amount of electricity, water and natural gas used by the city or governmental entity for its services in 2010.
- 2) The total amount paid for electricity, water and natural gas in 2010.

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2010

The City of Victoria purchases natural gas from Centerpoint Energy Entex. In Calendar Year 2010, the City purchased a total of 18,726 CCF of natural gas.

The City of Victoria purchases electricity from Direct Energy ¹ and Victoria Electric Coop. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 18,168,688 kilowatt hours.

The City of Victoria is a municipal water supplier and does not purchase water. ² In calendar year 2010, all City locations combined used a total of 174,108,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas and electricity purchased by the City in the calendar year 2010 was \$2,556,073.

¹ As a TCAP member, the City's provider will be Direct Energy. Some TCAP members may receive electric service on some city accounts from electric cooperatives. If this is the case, indicate all electric providers that provide service for city accounts and the total amount of electricity consumed by the city.

² If the City is a municipal water supplier and does not purchase water, simply note the amount of water consumed and report that as a self supplier, no municipal funds are expended to purchase water for municipal services.
