Charter Amendment Election was held on January 17, 1981. Composition of Council changed from 5 to 7 members, with staggered terms. A Charter Amendment Election was held on January 18, 1992 to change method of electing Council members. The Charter Revision Commission recommended that 4 single-member districts be established, with 2 members being elected At-Large and the Mayor being elected At-Large. This proposition failed by a margin of 37 votes. In the meantime, Mr. Alejandro M. Rojas filed a law suit concerning the method of electing Councilmembers, which was settled by establishing 4 single-member districts (numbered 1 through 4), 2 super districts (numbered 5 and 6), and the Mayor elected at large. Super district 5 is comprised of Districts 1 and 2, and Super District 6 is comprised of districts 3 and 4. The 4 single member district terms initially ran from August of 1992 to May of 1994, with 3-year terms thereafter. The Mayor and 2 super district terms initially ran from August of 1992 to May of 1995, with 3-year terms thereafter. Because of these terms there will be no election of City Councilmembers every third year. Due to the redistricting and the law suit, no Council election was held in May of 1992, but a special election was held on August 8, 1992 for the entire Council under the new district plan. The results of that election were:

An election for District 1, 2 and 3 was not held due to the fact that the incumbents were unopposed. In accordance with Section 2.051 through 2.053 of the Texas Election Code that requires a political subdivision to declare candidates elected to office and cancel the election if no candidates in the election are opposed.

Due to the fact that Joe Garcia resigned, a Special Election to fill his unexpired term in D5 was held in conjunction with the May 6, 2000 Joint General Election.

In accordance with Section 2.051 through 2.053 of the Texas Election Code that requires a political subdivision to declare candidates elected to office and cancel the election if no candidates in the election are opposed.

2003 – Philip Guittard (D1), Lewis Neitsch (D2), Bill Russell (D3), and Shirley Buckert (D4)

An election for District 1, 2, 3, and 4 was not held May 3, 2003 due to the fact that the incumbents were unopposed. In accordance with Section 2.051 through 2.053 of the Texas Election Code that requires a political subdivision to declare candidates elected to office and cancel the election if no candidates in the election are opposed.

2004 – Will Armstrong (Mayor), Jim Wyatt (D5), and Tom Halepaska (D6)

2005 – According to Charter, no election was held.

2006 – Philip Guittard (D1), Lewis Neitsch (D2)[Elected Mayor Pro-Tem 5-2006], and David Hagan (D4). Runoff election held Paul Polasek (D3).

An election for Mayor and Super Districts 5 and 6 was not held May 12, 2007 due to the fact that the incumbents were unopposed. In accordance with Section 2.051 through 2.053 of the Texas Election Code that requires a political subdivision to declare candidates elected to office and cancel the election if no candidates in the election are opposed.

2008 - According to Charter, no election was held.

**** Due to the fact that Jim Wyatt resigned, a Special Election to fill his unexpired term in D5 was held in conjunction with the May 9, 2009 Joint General Election.****

2009 – Gabriel Soliz (D2), Paul Polasek (D3), David Hagan (D4) and Joe Truman (D5). Runoff election held Denise Rangel (D1). Tom Halepaska elected by the Council as Mayor Pro-Tem 5-19-2009.
