



ACCIDENTAL SPILL NOTIFICATION

In the event of any discharge, including, but not limited to, accidental discharges, discharges of a nonroutine, episodic nature, a noncustomary batch discharge, or a slug load that may cause potential problems for the treatment plant, the user shall immediately telephone and notify the Department of Public Works Pretreatment Division of the incident. This notification shall include the location for the discharge, type of waste, concentration and volume (if known) and corrective actions taken by the user.

Failure to notify the Department of Public Works Pretreatment Division of potential problem discharges shall be deemed a violation of Ordinance 93-19.
